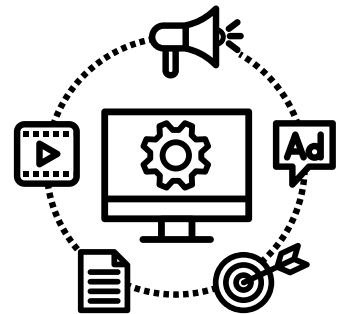

Judges will then select 20 finalists to participate in the final round: a live quiz event testing civics knowledge.
